HOW TO PLANT A BEE LAWN AT Home

Converting your yard into a bee lawn is simple, low cost, and low maintenance. If you are planting over an existing lawn, over-seed the area with bee lawn seed mixes. If you are planning a lawn renovation, bee lawns can be implemented during the landscaping process. Maintain as you would a regular lawn. Turn your yard into a colorful oasis of pollinator friendly flowers.

SPECIES TO Plant

Blue violet, Calico aster, Creeping thyme, Oregano, Golden alexander, Self Heal, Wild Lupine, Fine fescue, and Dutch white clover are great starters for you bee lawn.

POLLINATOR Gardens

If you want to keep your grass lawn but still adopt pollinator habitat in your yard, consider planting a pollinator garden. You can convert your garden into a pollinator garden simply by planting native flowering plants. Butterfly milkweed, pale purple cone flowers, sunflowers, bergamot, and fragrant hyssop are all great examples of flowering, pollen producing plants that bees love.
